Luke 2 · Matthew 1–2 (KJV)

In the days of Caesar Augustus, a decree went out that all the world should be taxed. So Joseph went up from Nazareth to Bethlehem with Mary, his espoused wife, who was great with child.

While they were there, the days were accomplished that she should be delivered. Mary brought forth her firstborn son, wrapped him in swaddling clothes, and laid him in a manger, because there was no room for them in the inn.

That same night, shepherds were watching over their flock. The angel of the Lord came upon them, and the glory of the Lord shone round about them. The angel said, 'Fear not: for, behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy... For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Saviour, which is Christ the Lord.' Then a great host of angels praised God, saying, 'Glory to God in the highest.'

Later, wise men came from the east, led by His star. They worshipped the young child and gave Him gifts of gold, and frankincense, and myrrh. They called His name Emmanuel, which means 'God with us.'
