Read the Bible Story

Exodus 14 (KJV)

After ten great plagues, Pharaoh finally let God's people leave Egypt. But soon his heart changed again, and he sent his army of horses and chariots to chase them down. The Israelites came to the shore of the Red Sea, and there they were trapped — the sea before them and Pharaoh's army behind them.

The people were terrified and cried out. But Moses said, 'Fear ye not, stand still, and see the salvation of the LORD. The LORD shall fight for you, and ye shall hold your peace.'

Then Moses stretched out his hand over the sea. The LORD sent a strong east wind that blew all night, and the waters were divided. The sea became dry land, with walls of water standing on the right and on the left.

All the Israelites — men, women, and children — walked safely through on the dry ground. When Pharaoh's army followed them in, Moses stretched out his hand again, and the sea returned to its place. Not one of the chariots was left.

On the other side, the people sang a song of praise to the LORD: 'The LORD is my strength and song, and he is become my salvation.'
