Read the Bible Story

Luke 10:25–37 (KJV)

A certain lawyer stood up to test Jesus and asked, 'Master, what shall I do to inherit eternal life?' Jesus said, 'What is written in the law?' The lawyer answered, 'Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and thy neighbour as thyself.' Jesus said, 'Thou hast answered right: this do, and thou shalt live.' But the lawyer asked, 'And who is my neighbour?'

Jesus told a story. A certain man went down from Jerusalem to Jericho. On the road thieves fell upon him, stripped him of his clothes, wounded him, and left him half dead.

By chance a priest came down that way. When he saw the man, he passed by on the other side. Soon a Levite came along, looked at him, and also passed by on the other side. Both knew the law of God, but neither one stopped to help.

Then a certain Samaritan came along. (The Jews and Samaritans hated each other.) When he saw the wounded man, he had compassion on him. He went to him, bound up his wounds, poured in oil and wine, set him on his own beast, and brought him to an inn. The next day he gave the innkeeper money and said, 'Take care of him; whatsoever thou spendest more, when I come again, I will repay thee.'

Jesus asked the lawyer, 'Which now of these three, thinkest thou, was neighbour unto him that fell among the thieves?' He answered, 'He that shewed mercy on him.' Then Jesus said, 'Go, and do thou likewise.'
