Read the Bible Story

Matthew 28 · Luke 24 (KJV)

After Jesus died on the cross, a good man named Joseph of Arimathaea wrapped His body in clean linen and laid Him in a new tomb cut from rock. A great stone was rolled against the door, and soldiers were set to guard it.

Very early on the first day of the week, while it was yet dark, certain women came to the tomb with sweet spices. As they came, there was a great earthquake. An angel of the Lord descended from heaven, rolled back the stone, and sat upon it. His face shined like lightning, and his clothing was white as snow. The guards shook for fear and became as dead men.

The angel said to the women, 'Fear not ye: for I know that ye seek Jesus, which was crucified. He is not here: for he is risen, as he said. Come, see the place where the Lord lay.'

The women ran with great joy to tell the disciples. As they ran, Jesus Himself met them and said, 'All hail.' That same evening He appeared to two disciples on the road to Emmaus, and then to the eleven gathered together. He showed them His hands and His side, and they were glad when they saw the Lord.

Because Jesus rose from the dead, death has no more power over those who believe in Him. He is alive forever, and one day He will raise all His people to live with Him.
