For a mother-to-be, or as a group devotion at a Christian baby shower.

Sweet KJV scriptures for baby shower cards, invitations, decorations, and nursery gifts.

How to use this pack

- Use one page as a shower devotion and give the rest to the mother.
- Guests can each write a prompt answer as a blessing card.
- Keep the completed pack with the baby book.

The seven days

Day 1 — Children as a heritage · Psalm 139:13-14

Day 2 — Blessing spoken over her · Psalm 127:3

Day 3 — Practical love · Jeremiah 1:5

Day 4 — Wisdom for parenting · Isaiah 49:15

Day 5 — Faith over fear · Mark 10:14

Day 6 — A praying circle · 3 John 1:2

Day 7 — A verse for the child · Proverbs 22:6

A baby shower celebrates the joyful anticipation of new life — a gift from God. These King James Bible verses remind us that every child is fearfully and wonderfully made, knit together by the Creator in the womb. Use these scriptures on invitations, decorations, gift cards, nursery art, and in your personal prayers for the mother and child to come.

Children as a heritage

For thou hast possessed my reins: thou hast covered me in my mother's womb. I will praise thee; for I am fearfully and wonderfully made: marvellous are thy works; and that my soul knoweth right well.

Psalm 139:13-14 (KJV)

God's handiwork in the womb

Devotion prompt

Read Psalm 127 aloud. What does it mean for this community to receive a child as a reward rather than a burden?

Write your answer

Pray it back to God before you close the page.

Blessing spoken over her

Lo, children are an heritage of the Lord: and the fruit of the womb is his reward.

Psalm 127:3 (KJV)

Children are God's gift

Devotion prompt

Write one sentence of blessing for the mother, not the baby. Mothers are often the last to be blessed at a shower.

Write your answer

Pray it back to God before you close the page.

Practical love

Before I formed thee in the belly I knew thee; and before thou camest forth out of the womb I sanctified thee, and I ordained thee a prophet unto the nations.

Jeremiah 1:5 (KJV)

Known by God before birth

Devotion prompt

Beyond a gift, what will you actually do in the first six weeks? Meals, laundry, holding the baby while she sleeps — write it and mean it.

Write your answer

Pray it back to God before you close the page.

Wisdom for parenting

Can a woman forget her sucking child, that she should not have compassion on the son of her womb? yea, they may forget, yet will I not forget thee.

Isaiah 49:15 (KJV)

A mother's unforgettable bond

Devotion prompt

Which piece of parenting wisdom has held up in your own life? Pass it on in a sentence, not a lecture.

Write your answer

Pray it back to God before you close the page.

Faith over fear

Suffer the little children to come unto me, and forbid them not: for of such is the kingdom of God.

Mark 10:14 (KJV)

Jesus welcomes every child

Devotion prompt

What fear would you gently name and pray over with this mother today?

Write your answer

Pray it back to God before you close the page.

A praying circle

Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth.

3 John 1:2 (KJV)

A prayer for health and prosperity

Devotion prompt

Who in this room will still be praying for this child in five years? Say so out loud.

Write your answer

Pray it back to God before you close the page.

A verse for the child

Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it.

Proverbs 22:6 (KJV)

A promise for parents

Devotion prompt

Choose a verse to give the child as their own, and write why you chose it.

Write your answer

Pray it back to God before you close the page.

More verses for this season

Keep this page for cards, texts, and the days when you need different words.

For this child I prayed; and the Lord hath given me my petition which I asked of him.

1 Samuel 1:27 (KJV)

Hannah's answered prayer

He shall feed his flock like a shepherd: he shall gather the lambs with his arm, and carry them in his bosom, and shall gently lead those that are with young.

Isaiah 40:11 (KJV)

God's gentle care for mothers

And he will love thee, and bless thee, and multiply thee: he will also bless the fruit of thy womb.

- 1 Samuel 1:27 works beautifully on a baby shower cake or centerpiece
- Use Psalm 127:3 for a short and sweet card inscription
- Isaiah 40:11 is a lovely verse to include in a prayer for the expectant mother
- Mark 10:14 makes a wonderful nursery wall decoration
