

A 7-Day Confirmation Reading Pack

For a young person preparing for confirmation, and for their sponsor.

Meaningful KJV scriptures for confirmation, first communion, and professing personal faith.

How to use this pack

- Read one page a day in the final week of preparation.
- Sponsors should answer the same prompts and compare notes.
- Bring day seven to the confirmation service.

The seven days

Day 1 — Making faith your own · Joshua 1:9

Day 2 — Knowing what you believe · Philippians 4:13

Day 3 — The Spirit's help · 2 Timothy 1:7

Day 4 — Standing firm · Romans 10:9-10

Day 5 — Gifts to use · Proverbs 3:5-6

Day 6 — A rule of life · Galatians 2:20

Day 7 — Your confirmation verse · Ephesians 2:8-9

Confirmation and first communion are sacred milestones in a young believer's spiritual journey — a public profession of the faith planted in their heart. These King James Bible verses celebrate the gift of the Holy Spirit, the importance of growing in faith, and the call to follow Christ wholeheartedly. Use these scriptures on confirmation cards, gifts, church programs, and in your prayers for the young person stepping into a deeper walk with God.

Making faith your own

Devotion prompt

- Proverbs 3:5-6 is a timeless verse for young people beginning their faith journey
