

A 7-Day Reading Pack Through Infertility

For couples walking through infertility, treatment, or unexplained waiting.

KJV scriptures for couples walking through infertility — honest lament, God's nearness, and hope that does not depend on an outcome.

How to use this pack

- One page a day, or one a month. This is a long road.
- Nothing here promises you a baby or explains the delay.
- Day five is for church, which is often the hardest room to sit in.

The seven days

Day 1 — The monthly grief · 1 Samuel 1:10

Day 2 — Prayer without formula · Psalm 34:18

Day 3 — Between the two of you · Psalm 62:8

Day 4 — Other people's news · Romans 12:15

Day 5 — Church on Mother's Day · Isaiah 55:8-9

Day 6 — God's goodness in the waiting · Psalm 147:3

Day 7 — Naming the next step · Isaiah 54:1

Infertility is a grief with no funeral. It repeats monthly, it is largely invisible, and well-meant encouragement often makes it worse. Scripture does not rush it: Hannah weeps in the temple, Sarah laughs bitterly, Rachel says give me children or I die. These King James verses hold space for lament and for hope, without promising an outcome the Bible does not promise.

The monthly grief

And she was in bitterness of soul, and prayed unto the LORD, and wept sore.

1 Samuel 1:10 (KJV)

Hannah's prayer — grief permitted

Devotion prompt

Hope deferred maketh the heart sick. Describe what that sickness actually feels like for you.

Write your answer

Pray it back to God before you close the page.

Prayer without formula

The LORD is nigh unto them that are of a broken heart; and saveth such as be of a contrite spirit.

Psalm 34:18 (KJV)

Nearness, not explanation

Devotion prompt

Hannah prayed in bitterness of soul and was not rebuked. Pray that honestly today.

Write your answer

Pray it back to God before you close the page.

Between the two of you

Trust in him at all times; ye people, pour out your heart before him: God is a refuge for us.

Psalm 62:8 (KJV)

Permission to pour it all out

Devotion prompt

Infertility strains a marriage. What do you need from each other that has not been said?

Write your answer

Pray it back to God before you close the page.

Other people's news

Rejoice with them that do rejoice, and weep with them that weep.

Romans 12:15 (KJV)

For baby showers and announcements

Devotion prompt

How do you handle pregnancy announcements? Decide in advance what you are allowed to do — leave, cry, decline.

Write your answer

Pray it back to God before you close the page.

Church on Mother's Day

For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, saith the LORD.

Isaiah 55:8-9 (KJV)

When there is no answer given

Devotion prompt

Which services will be hard this year? Plan for them rather than being ambushed.

Write your answer

Pray it back to God before you close the page.

God's goodness in the waiting

He healeth the broken in heart, and bindeth up their wounds.

Psalm 147:3 (KJV)

Healing of the heart, month after month

Devotion prompt

What do you still believe about God's character when the answer has been no so far?

Write your answer

Pray it back to God before you close the page.

Naming the next step

Sing, O barren, thou that didst not bear; break forth into singing... saith the LORD.

Isaiah 54:1 (KJV)

A promise spoken directly to the childless

Devotion prompt

Treatment, adoption, rest, a pause — what is the next decision, and when will you make it?

Write your answer

Pray it back to God before you close the page.

More verses for this season

Keep this page for cards, texts, and the days when you need different words.

The Father of mercies, and the God of all comfort; Who comforteth us in all our tribulation.

2 Corinthians 1:3-4 (KJV)

Comfort that can later be given away

Wait on the LORD: be of good courage, and he shall strengthen thine heart.

Psalms 27:14 (KJV)

For the waiting itself

A prayer for this season

Lord, you know the longing we carry every month. Hear us, hold our marriage together, and be gentle with us in the waiting. Amen.

Practical ways to use these verses

- 1 Samuel 1 is worth reading in full — Hannah's grief is recorded without correction, which is its own comfort.
- Avoid sending Jeremiah 29:11 to someone in this season; Psalm 34:18 lands honestly instead.
- Romans 12:15 is for friends and family as much as for the couple.
