

A 7-Day Job Interview Reading Pack

For anyone preparing for an interview or waiting on a decision.

Calming KJV scriptures and prayers for confidence, favor, and peace before a job interview.

How to use this pack

- Read one page a day in the week before the interview.
- Day seven is written for the waiting afterwards.
- Short answers are fine; the point is a steady head.

The seven days

Day 1 — Commit thy works · Joshua 1:9

Day 2 — Preparation is not faithlessness · Proverbs 16:3

Day 3 — Fear of rejection · Philippians 4:6-7

Day 4 — Honesty in the room · Psalm 5:12

Day 5 — Favour · Luke 12:11-12

Day 6 — Whatever the answer · 2 Timothy 1:7

Day 7 — Waiting · Proverbs 3:5-6

The night before a job interview can be filled with nerves, self-doubt, and racing thoughts. Whether this interview is your dream opportunity or a needed step after job loss, God is not absent from the process. These King James Bible verses are for the morning of the interview, the drive there, and the moments in the waiting room. Pray them aloud. Carry one in your pocket. Remember that God opens doors no man can shut, and He goes before you into that room.

Commit thy works

Be strong and of a good courage; be not afraid, neither be thou dismayed: for the Lord thy God is with thee whithersoever thou goest.

Joshua 1:9 (KJV)

God goes with you into the interview room

Devotion prompt

Commit thy works unto the LORD, and thy thoughts shall be established. What does committing this application actually involve for you?

Write your answer

Pray it back to God before you close the page.

Preparation is not faithlessness

Commit thy works unto the Lord, and thy thoughts shall be established.

Proverbs 16:3 (KJV)

Commit the interview to God beforehand

Devotion prompt

What preparation have you avoided because you called it trusting God?

Write your answer

Pray it back to God before you close the page.

Fear of rejection

Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God. And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

Philippians 4:6-7 (KJV)

Peace that quiets pre-interview nerves

Devotion prompt

What would this rejection say about you that you are afraid is true? Answer it with Scripture, not self-talk.

Write your answer

Pray it back to God before you close the page.

Honesty in the room

For thou, Lord, wilt bless the righteous; with favour wilt thou compass him as with a shield.

Psalm 5:12 (KJV)

Asking for God's favor in the room

Devotion prompt

Which question are you hoping they do not ask? Prepare a true answer instead of a clever one.

Write your answer

Pray it back to God before you close the page.

Favour

Take ye no thought how or what thing ye shall answer, or what ye shall say: For the Holy Ghost shall teach you in the same hour what ye ought to say.

Luke 12:11-12 (KJV)

The Holy Spirit gives you the right words

Devotion prompt

God gave Joseph favour in a foreign house. Pray for favour without treating it as a formula.

Write your answer

Pray it back to God before you close the page.

Whatever the answer

For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.

2 Timothy 1:7 (KJV)

Sound mind for clear answers

Devotion prompt

Write the sentence you will pray if the answer is no. Write it before you know.

Write your answer

Pray it back to God before you close the page.

Trust God with the outcome

Write your answer

More verses for this season

Keep this page for cards, texts, and the days when you need different words.

Fear thou not; for I am with thee: be not dismayed; for I am thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee.

Isaiah 41:10 (KJV)

Strength when nerves rise

Behold, I have set before thee an open door, and no man can shut it.

Revelation 3:8 (KJV)

God opens doors no one can shut

A prayer for this season

Father, you know what I need before I ask. Steady me in the interview, give me honest words, and let the outcome be yours rather than mine. Amen.

Practical ways to use these verses

- Pray Joshua 1:9 aloud right before walking into the building
- Memorize Psalm 5:12 — 'favour wilt thou compass him as with a shield' — and pray it in the waiting room
- Philippians 4:6-7 is for the night before, to help you actually sleep
- Luke 12:11-12 reminds you the Holy Spirit can give you the right words when your mind goes blank
- If this is after a job loss, pair these with our Job Loss verses for the full season
