

A 7-Day Mother's Day Reading Pack

For mothers, and for anyone honouring one — including those for whom the day is hard.

Beautiful KJV scriptures to honor mothers on Mother's Day — for cards, church services, and social media.

How to use this pack

- Read one page a day in the week before Mother's Day.
- Day five is written for those grieving or without children; do not skip it.
- Churches may reprint this pack freely for a women's ministry.

The seven days

Day 1 — Honour · Proverbs 31:28-29

Day 2 — A mother's faith · Proverbs 31:25-26

Day 3 — Strength and dignity · Proverbs 22:6

Day 4 — Weariness · Isaiah 66:13

Day 5 — When the day hurts · Exodus 20:12

Day 6 — Mothering others · Proverbs 1:8-9

Day 7 — Blessing spoken · 2 Timothy 1:5

Mother's Day is a time to honor the women who have nurtured, loved, and shaped our lives. The Bible speaks highly of mothers and the gift of motherhood, from the tender care of a mother's love to the wisdom she passes on to her children. These King James Bible verses celebrate mothers and are perfect for cards, church services, social media tributes, and personal reflections of gratitude.

Honour

*Her children arise up, and call her blessed; her husband also, and he praiseth her.
Many daughters have done virtuously, but thou excellest them all.*

Proverbs 31:28-29 (KJV)
