How to use this pack

- Read one page a day in the first week, boxes and all.
- Walk the house as you read — a different room each day.
- Finish with a house blessing on day seven.

The seven days

Day 1 — The Lord builds · Joshua 24:15

Day 2 — As for me and my house · Psalm 127:1

Day 3 — Hospitality · Proverbs 24:3-4

Day 4 — Peace within the walls · Deuteronomy 28:6

Day 5 — Contentment · Proverbs 3:33

Day 6 — A house of prayer · Psalm 91:1-2

Day 7 — House blessing · Numbers 6:24-26

These King James Bible verses speak of God's protection over our dwelling places, the blessing of building a home on a spiritual foundation, and the joy of inviting God's presence into every room. The Lord builds

And if it seem evil unto you to serve the Lord, choose you this day whom ye will serve; whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the flood, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but as for me and my house, we will serve the Lord.
