## Answer Key & Explanations

**Q1.** According to the first chapter, what is the preaching of the cross to them that perish?

**Answer:** B. Foolishness

Paul writes that the preaching of the cross is to them that perish foolishness. (1 Corinthians 1:18, KJV)

**Q2.** Paul declares that he determined not to know any thing among the Corinthians, save whom?

**Answer:** A. Jesus Christ, and him crucified

Paul focused his ministry among them solely on the person and work of Jesus Christ. (1 Corinthians 2:2, KJV)

**Q3.** Who does Paul say planted and who watered, though God gave the increase?

**Answer:** C. Paul planted, Apollos watered

Paul uses this agricultural metaphor to show that God alone deserves the glory. (1 Corinthians 3:6, KJV)

**Q4.** What does Paul say is required in stewards?

**Answer:** A. That a man be found faithful

It is required in stewards, that a man be found faithful. (1 Corinthians 4:2, KJV)

**Q5.** Paul instructs the church to purge out the old leaven that they may be what?

**Answer:** B. A new lump

The church is exhorted to be a new lump, as they are unleavened. (1 Corinthians 5:7, KJV)

**Q6.** What does Paul say is the price with which the believers were bought?

**Answer:** C. A price

The text states 'For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body.' (1 Corinthians 6:20, KJV)

**Q7.** Knowledge puffeth up, but what edifieth?

**Answer:** C. Charity

Paul contrasts the pride of knowledge with the building power of charity. (1 Corinthians 8:1, KJV)

**Q8.** Paul says he is made all things to all men, that he might by all means do what?

**Answer:** B. Save some

Paul adapted his approach to different people to win them to the gospel. (1 Corinthians 9:22, KJV)

**Q9.** In the famous chapter on charity, which of these is NOT mentioned as one of the three that abide?

**Answer:** D. Peace

The three that abide are faith, hope, and charity. (1 Corinthians 13:13, KJV)

**Q10.** What is described as the last enemy that shall be destroyed?

**Answer:** B. Death

Paul teaches that the final victory of Christ includes the destruction of death. (1 Corinthians 15:26, KJV)
