**Q1.** According to the first chapter, to what kind of inheritance are believers begotten?

**Answer:** A. An inheritance incorruptible, and undefiled

Peter describes an inheritance that fadeth not away, reserved in heaven. (1 Peter 1:4, KJV)

**Q2.** What does Peter say is 'much more precious than of gold that perisheth'?

**Answer:** B. The trial of your faith

The trial of faith is tried with fire to be found unto praise and honor. (1 Peter 1:7, KJV)

**Q3.** Peter commands the believers to be holy in all manner of conversation because of what reason?

**Answer:** B. Because it is written, Be ye holy; for I am holy

Peter quotes the commandment of the Lord regarding holiness. (1 Peter 1:16, KJV)

**Q4.** As what kind of stones are believers built up into a spiritual house?

**Answer:** B. Lively stones

Ye also, as lively stones, are built up a spiritual house, an holy priesthood. (1 Peter 2:5, KJV)

**Q5.** How should believers submit themselves to every ordinance of man for the Lord's sake?

**Answer:** C. For the Lord's sake

Believers are told to submit to ordinances, whether to the king or governors. (1 Peter 2:13, KJV)

**Q6.** By whose stripes were ye healed, according to Peter?

**Answer:** C. Christ

Peter refers to Christ's suffering, by whose stripes ye were healed. (1 Peter 2:24, KJV)

**Q7.** What should a believer be ready always to give to every man that asketh?

**Answer:** B. A reason of the hope that is in you

We are to be ready to give an answer with meekness and fear. (1 Peter 3:15, KJV)

**Q8.** How many souls were saved by water in the days of Noah?

**Answer:** C. Eight

Peter notes that few, that is, eight souls were saved by water. (1 Peter 3:20, KJV)

**Q9.** What does Peter say 'shall cover the multitude of sins'?

**Answer:** A. Charity

Above all things have fervent charity among yourselves. (1 Peter 4:8, KJV)

**Q10.** Who does Peter describe as a 'roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour'?

**Answer:** C. Your adversary the devil

Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil walketh about. (1 Peter 5:8, KJV)
