**Q1.** According to the first chapter, what is the 'end of the commandment'?

**Answer:** B. Charity out of a pure heart

Paul states the end of the commandment is charity out of a pure heart and a good conscience. (1 Timothy 1:5, KJV)

**Q2.** Paul describes himself as the 'chief' of what group?

**Answer:** C. Sinners

Paul writes that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners, of whom he is chief. (1 Timothy 1:15, KJV)

**Q3.** How many mediators does Paul say are between God and men?

**Answer:** B. One

There is one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus. (1 Timothy 2:5, KJV)

**Q4.** A bishop must be 'the husband of' how many wives?

**Answer:** C. One

The scripture requires a bishop to be blameless, the husband of one wife. (1 Timothy 3:2, KJV)

**Q5.** What does Paul call the 'pillar and ground of the truth'?

**Answer:** B. The house of God, which is the church

The house of God is the church of the living God, the pillar and ground of the truth. (1 Timothy 3:15, KJV)

**Q6.** Paul warns that in the latter times, some shall depart from the faith, giving heed to what?

**Answer:** A. Seducing spirits and doctrines of devils

The Spirit speaketh expressly that some shall depart, giving heed to seducing spirits. (1 Timothy 4:1, KJV)

**Q7.** What does Paul tell Timothy not to let any man despise?

**Answer:** C. His youth

Paul encourages Timothy, 'Let no man despise thy youth.' (1 Timothy 4:12, KJV)

**Q8.** According to chapter 5, if any provide not for his own house, he is worse than what?

**Answer:** B. An infidel

He that provideth not for his own hath denied the faith and is worse than an infidel. (1 Timothy 5:8, KJV)

**Q9.** What is described as 'the root of all evil'?

**Answer:** B. The love of money

Paul writes that the love of money is the root of all evil. (1 Timothy 6:10, KJV)

**Q10.** What is said to be 'great gain' when combined with contentment?

**Answer:** C. Godliness

The scripture states that godliness with contentment is great gain. (1 Timothy 6:6, KJV)
