Answer Key & Explanations

Q1. How does Paul describe God in the first chapter of this epistle?

Answer: A. The Father of mercies, and the God of all comfort

Paul identifies God as the Father of mercies and the God of all comfort. (2 Corinthians 1:3, KJV)

Q2. Paul writes that we are not ignorant of whose devices?

Answer: B. Satan

Paul warns that we should not be ignorant of Satan's devices. (2 Corinthians 2:11, KJV)

Q3. According to Paul, the letter killeth, but what giveth life?

Answer: C. The spirit

The scripture states that 'the letter killeth, but the spirit giveth life.' (2 Corinthians 3:6, KJV)

Q4. In what kind of vessels does Paul say we have this treasure?

Answer: B. Earthen vessels

Paul says we have this treasure in earthen vessels, that the excellency of the power may be of God. (2 Corinthians 4:7, KJV)

Q5. Paul states that we walk by what, and not by sight?

The scripture says that 'God loveth a cheerful giver.' (2 Corinthians 9:7, KJV)

Q8. Paul mentions being caught up to which heaven?

Answer: C. The third heaven

Paul speaks of a man in Christ caught up to the third heaven. (2 Corinthians 12:2, KJV)

Q9. What did the Lord say to Paul when he besought Him to remove the thorn in his flesh?

Answer: B. My grace is sufficient for thee

The Lord answered Paul, 'My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness.' (2 Corinthians 12:9, KJV)

Q10. With what does Paul tell the Corinthians to greet one another?

Answer: A. A holy kiss

Paul instructs the brethren to 'Greet one another with an holy kiss.' (2 Corinthians 13:12, KJV)
