Answer Key & Explanations

Q1. To whom is the second epistle of John addressed?

Answer: B. The elect lady and her children

The elder writes specifically to the elect lady and her children, whom he loves in the truth. (2 John 1:1, KJV)

Q2. How long does John say the truth shall be with those who know it?

Answer: C. For ever

John states the truth dwelleth in us and shall be with us for ever. (2 John 1:2, KJV)

Q3. John rejoiced greatly because he found the lady's children doing what?

Answer: A. Walking in truth

He rejoiced greatly that he found of her children walking in truth. (2 John 1:4, KJV)

Q4. What is the definition of love according to this epistle?

Answer: B. That we walk after his commandments

The text says, 'And this is love, that we walk after his commandments.' (2 John 1:6, KJV)

Q5. What specific false teaching identifies a 'deceiver and an antichrist'?

Answer: C. Confessing not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh

Many deceivers enter the world who confess not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh. (2 John 1:7, KJV)

Q6. What does John warn the believers to look to themselves for, lest they lose it?

Answer: B. Those things which we have wrought

He warns them to look to themselves so they lose not those things which they have wrought. (2 John 1:8, KJV)

Q7. Whosoever transgresseth and abideth not in the doctrine of Christ has not what?

Answer: C. God

The scripture states that he that abideth not in the doctrine of Christ 'hath not God.' (2 John 1:9, KJV)

Q8. If someone comes and brings not the doctrine of Christ, what should a believer NOT do?

Answer: A. Receive him into their house

John instructs not to receive such a person into your house, neither bid him God speed. (2 John 1:10, KJV)

Q9. What happens to a person who bids 'God speed' to one who brings false doctrine?

Answer: B. He is a partaker of his evil deeds

He that biddeth him God speed is partaker of his evil deeds. (2 John 1:11, KJV)

Q10. Why did John choose not to write more things with paper and ink?

Answer: C. He trusted to come unto them and speak face to face

John hoped to come and speak face to face, that their joy might be full. (2 John 1:12, KJV)
