Q1. How did the prophet Elijah depart from this world into heaven?

Answer: A. In a whirlwind with a chariot of fire

There appeared a chariot of fire, and horses of fire, and Elijah went up by a whirlwind. (2 Kings 2:11, KJV)

Q2. What did Elisha request from Elijah before he was taken away?

Answer: B. A double portion of thy spirit

Elisha asked, 'I pray thee, let a double portion of thy spirit be upon me.' (2 Kings 2:9, KJV)

Q3. What did Elisha cast into the spring of waters at Jericho to heal them?

Answer: C. Salt

He went forth unto the spring of the waters, and cast the salt in there. (2 Kings 2:21, KJV)

Q4. Who was the captain of the host of the king of Syria that was a leper?

Answer: C. Naaman

Naaman was a great man with his master, but he was a leper. (2 Kings 5:1, KJV)

Q5. How many times did Elisha tell Naaman to wash in the Jordan to be clean?

Answer: B. Seven times

Elisha sent a messenger saying, 'Go and wash in Jordan seven times.' (2 Kings 5:10, KJV)

Q6. What object did Elisha make to swim after it had fallen into the water?

Answer: C. An iron axe head

He cut down a stick, and cast it in thither; and the iron did swim. (2 Kings 6:6, KJV)

Q7. Who was the wicked queen of Judah who attempted to destroy all the seed royal?

Answer: B. Athaliah

When Athaliah the mother of Ahaziah saw that her son was dead, she arose and destroyed all the seed royal. (2 Kings 11:1, KJV)

Q8. How old was Josiah when he began to reign over Judah?

Answer: A. Eight years old

Josiah was eight years old when he began to reign. (2 Kings 22:1, KJV)

Q9. What was found in the house of the Lord during the reign of Josiah?

Answer: B. The book of the law

Hilkiah the high priest said, 'I have found the book of the law in the house of the Lord.' (2 Kings 22:8, KJV)

Q10. Which king of Babylon besieged Jerusalem and carried Judah away into captivity?

Answer: C. Nebuchadnezzar

Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon came, he, and all his host, against Jerusalem. (2 Kings 25:1, KJV)
