## Answer Key & Explanations

**Q1.** According to the opening verse, to whom is this epistle addressed?

**Answer:** B. To them that have obtained like precious faith

Peter writes to those who have obtained 'like precious faith' through righteousness. (2 Peter 1:1, KJV)

**Q2.** What does Peter say has been given unto us through the knowledge of Him?

**Answer:** A. All things that pertain unto life and godliness

His divine power hath given us all things pertaining to life and godliness. (2 Peter 1:3, KJV)

**Q3.** In the 'ladder of faith,' what virtue is to be added immediately after 'temperance'?

**Answer:** C. Patience

The sequence is temperance, then patience, then godliness. (2 Peter 1:6, KJV)

**Q4.** Peter states that prophecy came not in old time by the will of man, but by what means?

**Answer:** D. Holy men of God spake as they were moved by the Holy Ghost

Prophecy was delivered as holy men were moved by the Holy Ghost. (2 Peter 1:21, KJV)

**Q5.** Whom did God save as the 'eighth person' when He brought the flood upon the world of the ungodly?

**Answer:** B. Noah

Noah is described as a preacher of righteousness and the eighth person saved. (2 Peter 2:5, KJV)

**Q6.** Which Old Testament figure is described as 'just' and 'vexed with the filthy conversation of the wicked'?

**Answer:** A. Lot

God delivered just Lot, who was vexed by the behavior of the wicked in Sodom. (2 Peter 2:7, KJV)

**Q7.** Peter uses a proverb about which animal returning to its own vomit?

**Answer:** C. A dog

The proverb describes a dog turning to his own vomit again. (2 Peter 2:22, KJV)

**Q8.** What specific measurement of time does Peter use to describe the Lord's perspective?

**Answer:** A. One day is as a thousand years

One day is with the Lord as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day. (2 Peter 3:8, KJV)

**Q9.** How will the day of the Lord come, according to Peter?

**Answer:** B. As a thief in the night

The day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night. (2 Peter 3:10, KJV)

**Q10.** Whose epistles does Peter mention, noting that they contain 'some things hard to be understood'?

**Answer:** D. Paul

Peter refers to the writings of 'our beloved brother Paul.' (2 Peter 3:15, KJV)
