Answer Key & Explanations

Q1. According to the first chapter, Paul, Silvanus, and Timotheus thanked God because the Thessalonians' faith grew how?

Answer: A. Exceedingly

Paul writes that 'your faith groweth exceedingly' in his opening thanksgiving. (2 Thessalonians 1:3, KJV)

Q2. When the Lord Jesus is revealed from heaven with his mighty angels, how will he appear?

Answer: B. In flaming fire

The text states He shall be revealed 'In flaming fire taking vengeance on them that know not God'. (2 Thessalonians 1:8, KJV)

Q3. Paul warns the brethren not to be soon shaken in mind or troubled concerning what event?

Answer: B. The day of Christ

Paul exhorts them not to be troubled 'as that the day of Christ is at hand'. (2 Thessalonians 2:2, KJV)

Q4. What must happen before the day of Christ comes, according to chapter 2?

Answer: B. A falling away first

Paul says that day shall not come, 'except there come a falling away first'. (2 Thessalonians 2:3, KJV)

Q5. Who is described as the one who 'opposeth and exalteth himself above all that is called God'?

Answer: A. The son of perdition

The 'man of sin' is identified as the 'son of perdition' who exalts himself. (2 Thessalonians 2:4, KJV)

Q6. Where does the 'man of sin' sit, shewing himself that he is God?

Answer: B. In the temple of God

He 'sitteth in the temple of God, shewing himself that he is God'. (2 Thessalonians 2:4, KJV)

Q7. What does Paul say is already at work in chapter 2?

Answer: B. The mystery of iniquity

Paul writes, 'For the mystery of iniquity doth already work'. (2 Thessalonians 2:7, KJV)

Q8. Paul requests prayer that the word of the Lord may have what?

Answer: B. Free course

He asks for prayer 'that the word of the Lord may have free course, and be glorified'. (2 Thessalonians 3:1, KJV)

Q9. What command did Paul give concerning those who would not work?

Answer: B. Neither should they eat

Paul commanded, 'that if any would not work, neither should he eat'. (2 Thessalonians 3:10, KJV)

Q10. How should the brethren treat a man who obeys not the word of the epistle?

Answer: B. Admonish him as a brother

Paul says to 'note that man', yet 'count him not as an enemy, but admonish him as a brother'. (2 Thessalonians 3:15, KJV)
