Answer Key & Explanations

Q1. Who was Aaron's father?

Answer: A. Amram

And Amram took him Jochebed his father's sister to wife; and she bare him Aaron and Moses. (Exodus 6:20) (Exodus 6:20, KJV)

Q2. What did the LORD say Aaron would be to Moses?

Answer: A. He shall be thy spokesman unto the people: and he shall be to thee instead of a mouth

And thou shalt speak unto him, and put words in his mouth: and I will be with thy mouth, and with his mouth, and will teach you what ye shall do. And he shall be thy spokesman unto the people: and he shall be to thee instead of a mouth. (Exodus 4:15-16) (Exodus 4:15, KJV)

Q3. What did Aaron cast for Israel at Sinai?

Answer: A. A golden calf from the golden earrings of the people

And he received them at their hand, and fashioned it with a graving tool, after he had made it a molten calf: and they said, These be thy gods, O Israel, which brought thee up out of the land of Egypt. (Exodus 32:4) (Exodus 32:4, KJV)

Q4. What did Aaron make to declare a feast to the LORD?

Answer: A. An altar before the calf

And when Aaron saw it, he built an altar before it; and Aaron made proclamation, and said, To morrow is a feast to the LORD. (Exodus 32:5) (Exodus 32:5, KJV)

Q5. What happened to Aaron's rod before Pharaoh?

Answer: A. It became a serpent, and swallowed up the rods of the magicians

And Moses and Aaron went in unto Pharaoh, and they did so as the LORD had commanded: and Aaron cast down his rod before Pharaoh, and before his servants, and it became a serpent. Then Pharaoh also called the wise men and the sorcerers... and they also did in like manner with their enchantments... but Aaron's rod swallowed up their rods. (Exodus 7:10-12) (Exodus 7:10, KJV)

Q6. What did Aaron's rod do in the tabernacle?

Answer: A. Budded, and brought forth buds, and bloomed blossoms, and yielded almonds

And it came to pass, that on the morrow Moses went into the tabernacle of witness; and, behold, the rod of Aaron for the house of Levi was budded, and brought forth buds, and bloomed blossoms, and yielded almonds. (Numbers 17:8) (Numbers 17:8, KJV)

Q7. Who was Aaron's wife?

Answer: A. Elisheba, the daughter of Amminadab

And Aaron took him Elisheba, the daughter of Amminadab, the sister of Naashon, to wife; and she bare him Nadab and Abihu, Eleazar and Ithamar. (Exodus 6:23) (Exodus 6:23, KJV)

Q8. What happened to Nadab and Abihu?

Answer: A. They offered strange fire before the LORD, and fire from the LORD devoured them

And Nadab and Abihu, the sons of Aaron, took either of them his censer, and put fire therein, and put incense thereon, and offered strange fire before the LORD, which he commanded them not. And there went out fire from the LORD, and devoured them, and they died before the LORD. (Leviticus 10:1-2) (Leviticus 10:1, KJV)

Q9. On what mountain did Aaron die?

Answer: A. Mount Hor

And Aaron the priest went up into mount Hor at the commandment of the LORD, and died there, in the fortieth year after the children of Israel were come out of the land of Egypt. (Numbers 33:38) (Numbers 33:38, KJV)

Q10. How long did Aaron serve as high priest?

Answer: A. About forty years

Aaron served as high priest from the establishment of the priesthood at Sinai until his death at Mount Hor in the fortieth year of Israel's wilderness wanderings. (Numbers 33:38-39) (Numbers 33:38, KJV)
