Q1. From what did God form Adam's body?

Answer: B. Dust of the ground

And the LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground. (Genesis 2:7, KJV)

Q2. What did God breathe into Adam?

Answer: B. The breath of life

And breathed into his nostrils the breath of life. (Genesis 2:7, KJV)

Q3. In what garden did God place Adam?

Answer: B. Eden

And the LORD God planted a garden eastward in Eden. (Genesis 2:8, KJV)

Q4. What was one of Adam's first tasks?

Answer: B. To name the animals

Whatsoever Adam called every living creature, that was the name thereof. (Genesis 2:19, KJV)

Q5. From what part of Adam did God form Eve?

Answer: B. His rib

The rib, which the LORD God had taken from man, made he a woman. (Genesis 2:22, KJV)

Q6. What tree were Adam and Eve forbidden to eat from?

Answer: B. The tree of knowledge of good and evil

But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it. (Genesis 2:17, KJV)

Q7. Who tempted Eve to eat of the forbidden fruit?

Now the serpent was more subtil than any beast of the field. (Genesis 3:1, KJV)

Q8. What did Adam and Eve make to cover themselves?
