Q2. Who declared Paul's case to Agrippa?

Answer: B. Festus

Acts 25:14 (KJV) — 'Festus declared Paul's cause unto the king.' (Acts 25:14, KJV)

Q3. To whom had Paul appealed?

Answer: B. Caesar

Acts 25:11 (KJV) — 'I appeal unto Caesar.' (Acts 25:11, KJV)

Q4. What did Paul stretch forth before Agrippa?

Answer: B. His hand

Acts 26:1 (KJV) — 'Paul stretched forth the hand, and answered for himself.' (Acts 26:1, KJV)
