**Q1. Who was Andrew's brother?**

**Answer:** B. Simon Peter

He first findeth his own brother Simon, and saith unto him, We have found the Messias, which is, being interpreted, the Christ. (John 1:41, KJV)

**Q2. Whose disciple was Andrew before he followed Jesus?**

**Answer:** B. John the Baptist

Again the next day after John stood, and two of his disciples; And looking upon Jesus as he walked, he saith, Behold the Lamb of God! And the two disciples heard him speak, and they followed Jesus. (John 1:35, KJV)

**Q3. What did Andrew say to Peter when he found Jesus?**

**Answer:** A. We have found the Messias, which is, being interpreted, the Christ

He first findeth his own brother Simon, and saith unto him, We have found the Messias, which is, being interpreted, the Christ. And he brought him to Jesus. (John 1:41, KJV)

**Q4. Where was Andrew from?**

**Answer:** B. Bethsaida of the city of Andrew and Peter

Now Philip was of Bethsaida, the city of Andrew and Peter. (John 1:44, KJV)

**Q5. What did Andrew tell Jesus about the boy with loaves and fishes?**

**Answer:** A. There is a lad here, which hath five barley loaves, and two small fishes

There is a lad here, which hath five barley loaves, and two small fishes: but what are they among so many? (John 6:9, KJV)

**Q6. What Greeks did Andrew bring to Jesus?**

**Answer:** A. Certain Greeks who wanted to see Jesus

And there were certain Greeks among them that came up to worship at the feast: The same came therefore to Philip, which was of Bethsaida of Galilee, and desired him, saying, Sir, we would see Jesus. Philip cometh and telleth Andrew: and again Andrew and Philip tell Jesus. (John 12:20, KJV)

**Q7. What did Andrew and Philip do when the Greeks wanted to see Jesus?**

**Answer:** A. They told Jesus together

Philip cometh and telleth Andrew: and again Andrew and Philip tell Jesus. (John 12:22, KJV)

**Q8. What was Andrew's role among the twelve?**

**Answer:** A. One of the twelve apostles, brother of Simon Peter

Andrew is named in all four apostolic lists as one of the twelve, the brother of Simon Peter. (Matthew 10:2, KJV)

**Q9. What did Andrew do when Jesus called him?**

**Answer:** A. He left his nets and followed Jesus immediately

And Jesus, walking by the sea of Galilee, saw two brethren, Simon called Peter, and Andrew his brother, casting a net into the sea: for they were fishers. And he saith unto them, Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men. And they straightway left their nets, and followed him. (Matthew 4:18, KJV)

**Q10.** What does Andrew's life teach?

**Answer:** A. That bringing one person to Jesus can change history — Andrew brought Peter, who became the rock of the church

Andrew's simple act of bringing his brother Simon to Jesus resulted in Peter's leadership in the early church. (John 1:42, KJV)
