Q1. Asa was king of which kingdom?

Answer: B. Judah

1 Kings 15:9 (KJV) — 'reigned Asa over Judah.' (1 Kings 15:9, KJV)

Q2. Whose son was Asa?

Answer: A. Abijam

1 Kings 15:8 (KJV) — 'Asa his son reigned in his stead.' (after Abijam) (1 Kings 15:8, KJV)

Q3. What did Asa remove from the land?

Answer: A. Idols and sodomites

1 Kings 15:12 (KJV) — 'he took away the sodomites... and removed all the idols.' (1 Kings 15:12, KJV)

Q4. Whom did Asa remove from being queen?

Answer: B. Maachah his mother

1 Kings 15:13 (KJV) — 'Maachah his mother, even her he removed from being queen.' (1 Kings 15:13, KJV)

Q5. Who came up against Asa with a huge army?

Answer: B. Zerah the Ethiopian

2 Chronicles 14:9 (KJV) — 'Zerah the Ethiopian with an host of a thousand thousand.' (2 Chronicles 14:9, KJV)

Q6. How large was Zerah's army?

Answer: D. A thousand thousand

2 Chronicles 14:9 (KJV) — 'a thousand thousand, and three hundred chariots.' (2 Chronicles 14:9, KJV)

Q7. Whom did Asa cry unto for help?

Answer: B. The LORD his God

2 Chronicles 14:11 (KJV) — 'Asa cried unto the LORD his God.' (2 Chronicles 14:11, KJV)

Q8. Whom did Asa later hire against Baasha of Israel?

Answer: B. Ben-hadad of Syria

2 Chronicles 16:2 (KJV) — sent silver and gold to 'Ben-hadad king of Syria.' (2 Chronicles 16:2, KJV)

Q9. What disease did Asa contract in his old age?

Answer: B. A disease in his feet

1 Kings 15:23 (KJV) — 'he was diseased in his feet.' (1 Kings 15:23, KJV)

Q10. Whom did Asa seek for his disease?

Answer: B. The physicians

2 Chronicles 16:12 (KJV) — 'in his disease he sought not to the LORD, but to the physicians.' (2 Chronicles 16:12, KJV)
