Answer Key & Explanations

Q1. Who was the prophetess and judge during Barak's time?

Answer: A. Deborah

And Deborah, a prophetess, the wife of Lapidoth, she judged Israel at that time. (Judges 4:4) (Judges 4:4, KJV)

Q2. From which tribe was Barak?

Answer: A. Naphtali

And she sent and called Barak the son of Abinoam out of Kedeshnaphtali. (Judges 4:6) (Judges 4:6, KJV)

Q3. What did Deborah command Barak to do?

Answer: A. Go and draw toward mount Tabor, and take ten thousand men

And she sent and called Barak... and said unto him, Hath not the LORD God of Israel commanded, saying, Go and draw toward mount Tabor, and take with thee ten thousand men? (Judges 4:6) (Judges 4:6, KJV)

Q4. What condition did Barak place on going to battle?

Answer: A. If thou wilt go with me, then I will go; but if thou wilt not go with me, then I will not go

And Barak said unto her, If thou wilt go with me, then I will go: but if thou wilt not go with me, then I will not go. (Judges 4:8) (Judges 4:8, KJV)

Q5. What did Deborah say about the honour of the journey?

Answer: A. The journey that thou takest shall not be for thine honour; for the LORD shall sell Sisera into the hand of a woman

And she said, I will surely go with thee: notwithstanding the journey that thou takest shall not be for thine honour; for the LORD shall sell Sisera into the hand of a woman. (Judges 4:9) (Judges 4:9, KJV)

Q6. How many men went up with Barak?

Answer: A. Ten thousand

And Barak called Zebulun and Naphtali to Kedesh; and he went up with ten thousand men at his feet. (Judges 4:10) (Judges 4:10, KJV)

Q7. How did the LORD discomfit Sisera and his chariots?

Answer: A. With the edge of the sword and by Sisera's chariots being swept away by the river Kishon

And the LORD discomfited Sisera, and all his chariots, and all his host, with the edge of the sword before Barak; so that Sisera lighted down off his chariot, and fled away on his feet. (Judges 4:15) (Judges 4:15, KJV)

Q8. Who killed Sisera?

Answer: A. Jael, the wife of Heber the Kenite

Then Jael Heber's wife took a nail of the tent, and took an hammer in her hand, and went softly unto him, and smote the nail into his temples, and fastened it into the ground. (Judges 4:21) (Judges 4:21, KJV)

Q9. What did Deborah and Barak do after the victory?

Answer: A. Sang a song of praise

Then sang Deborah and Barak the son of Abinoam on that day, saying, Praise ye the LORD for the avenging of Israel. (Judges 5:1-2) (Judges 5:1, KJV)

Q10. In Hebrews 11:32, who is mentioned alongside Barak in the hall of faith?

Answer: A. Gideon, Samson, Jephthah, David, Samuel, and the prophets

And what shall I more say? for the time would fail me to tell of Gedeon, and of Barak, and of Samson, and of Jephthae; of David also, and Samuel, and of the prophets. (Hebrews 11:32) (Hebrews 11:32, KJV)
