## Answer Key & Explanations

**Q1. What does the name Barnabas mean?**

**Answer: B. Son of consolation / exhortation**

And Joses, who by the apostles was surnamed Barnabas, (which is, being interpreted, The son of consolation,) a Levite, and of the country of Cyprus. (Acts 4:36, KJV)

**Q2. What did Barnabas sell and lay at the apostles' feet?**

**Answer: B. A field he owned**

Having land, sold it, and brought the money, and laid it at the apostles' feet. (Acts 4:37, KJV)

**Q3. Who did Barnabas bring to the apostles when others were afraid of him?**

**Answer: C. Saul of Tarsus / Paul**

But Barnabas took him, and brought him to the apostles, and declared unto them how he had seen the Lord in the way. (Acts 9:27, KJV)

**Q4. Where was Barnabas from?**

**Answer: C. Cyprus**

A Levite, and of the country of Cyprus. (Acts 4:36, KJV)

**Q5. What did Barnabas see in the church at Antioch?**

**Answer: B. The grace of God, and was glad**

Who, when he came, and had seen the grace of God, was glad, and exhorted them all, that with purpose of heart they would cleave unto the Lord. (Acts 11:23, KJV)

**Q6. Whom did Barnabas bring to Antioch to teach for a whole year?**

**Answer: B. Saul / Paul**

Then departed Barnabas to Tarsus, for to seek Saul: And when he had found him, he brought him unto Antioch. And it came to pass, that a whole year they assembled themselves with the church. (Acts 11:25, KJV)

**Q7. Barnabas and Paul were sent out as missionaries from which church?**

**Answer: B. Antioch**

As they ministered to the Lord, and fasted, the Holy Ghost said, Separate me Barnabas and Saul for the work whereunto I have called them... and they sent them away. (Acts 13:2, KJV)

**Q8. On their first missionary journey, where did Barnabas and Paul first preach?**

**Answer: B. Salamis in Cyprus**

So they, being sent forth by the Holy Ghost, departed unto Seleucia; and from thence they sailed to Cyprus. And when they were at Salamis, they preached the word of God in the synagogues of the Jews. (Acts 13:4, KJV)

**Q9. Why did Barnabas and Paul separate after their first journey?**

**Answer: A. A disagreement about whether to take John Mark with them again**

And the contention was so sharp between them, that they departed asunder one from the other: and so Barnabas took Mark, and sailed unto Cyprus. (Acts 15:39, KJV)

**Q10. What fruit of the Spirit is Barnabas especially remembered for?**

**Answer: C. Generosity and encouragement**

Barnabas exemplified generosity (selling his land), encouragement (bringing Paul to the apostles), and grace (seeing the good in others). (Acts 4:36, KJV)
