Q1. What city was Bartimaeus near when Jesus passed?

Answer: A. Jericho

And they came to Jericho: and as he went out of Jericho with his disciples and a great number of people, blind Bartimaeus, the son of Timaeus, sat by the highway side begging. (Mark 10:46, KJV)

Q2. Whose son was Bartimaeus?

Answer: A. Timaeus

Blind Bartimaeus, the son of Timaeus. (Mark 10:46, KJV)

Q3. What did Bartimaeus do for a living?

Answer: A. Sat begging by the highway

Bartimaeus... sat by the highway side begging. (Mark 10:46, KJV)

Q4. What did he cry out?

Answer: A. Jesus, thou son of David, have mercy on me

And when he heard that it was Jesus of Nazareth, he began to cry out, and say, Jesus, thou son of David, have mercy on me. (Mark 10:47, KJV)

Q5. What did the crowd do?

Answer: A. Charged him that he should hold his peace

And many charged him that he should hold his peace. (Mark 10:48, KJV)

Q6. How did he respond?

Answer: A. He cried the more a great deal

But he cried the more a great deal, Thou son of David, have mercy on me. (Mark 10:48, KJV)

Q7. What did Jesus command?

Answer: A. That he be called

And Jesus stood still, and commanded him to be called. (Mark 10:49, KJV)

Q8. What did Bartimaeus cast away as he came?

Answer: A. His garment

And he, casting away his garment, rose, and came to Jesus. (Mark 10:50, KJV)

Q9. What did Jesus ask him?

Answer: A. What wilt thou that I should do unto thee?

And Jesus answered and said unto him, What wilt thou that I should do unto thee? The blind man said unto him, Lord, that I might receive my sight. (Mark 10:51, KJV)

Q10. What did Jesus say had made him whole?

Answer: A. Thy faith hath made thee whole

And Jesus said unto him, Go thy way; thy faith hath made thee whole. And immediately he received his sight, and followed Jesus in the way. (Mark 10:52, KJV)
