Answer Key & Explanations

Q1. How many days did God take to create the world?

Answer: B. Six

And on the seventh day God ended his work which he had made; and he rested on the seventh day from all his work which he had made. (Genesis 2:2, KJV)

Q2. What number is often associated with completeness and rest in Scripture?

Answer: B. Seven

The number seven appears throughout Scripture — seven days of creation, seven seals, seven trumpets, seven churches. (Genesis 2:2, KJV)

Q3. How many disciples did Jesus choose as apostles?

Answer: C. Twelve

And he ordained twelve, that they should be with him, and that he might send them forth to preach. (Mark 3:14, KJV)

Q4. How many days and nights did it rain during Noah's Flood?

Answer: C. Forty

And the rain was upon the earth forty days and forty nights. (Genesis 7:12, KJV)

Q5. How many years did Israel wander in the wilderness?

Answer: C. Forty

Your children shall wander in the wilderness forty years, and bear your whoredoms. (Numbers 14:33, KJV)

Q6. What is the number of the beast in Revelation?

Answer: D. 666

Here is wisdom. Let him that hath understanding count the number of the beast: for it is the number of a man; and his number is Six hundred threescore and six. (Revelation 13:18, KJV)

Q7. How many books are in the Protestant Bible?

Answer: B. Sixty-six

The Bible contains 66 books — 39 in the Old Testament and 27 in the New Testament.

Q8. How many fish did the disciples catch after Jesus' resurrection?

Answer: B. One hundred and fifty-three

Simon Peter went up, and drew the net to land full of great fishes, an hundred and fifty and three: and for all there were so many, yet was not the net broken. (John 21:11, KJV)

Q9. How many days was Jesus in the tomb before His resurrection?

Answer: C. Three

For as Jonas was three days and three nights in the whale's belly; so shall the Son of man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth. (Matthew 12:40, KJV)

Q10. How many commandments did God give Moses on the stone tablets?

Answer: C. Ten

And he wrote upon the tables the words of the covenant, the ten commandments. (Exodus 34:28, KJV)
