## Answer Key & Explanations

### Q1. What kind of hope has God begotten us to?

**Answer:** A. A lively hope by the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, which according to his abundant mercy hath begotten us again unto a lively hope by the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead. (1 Peter 1:3, KJV)

### Q2. What is our inheritance?

**Answer:** A. Incorruptible, and undefiled, and that fadeth not away, reserved in heaven

To an inheritance incorruptible, and undefiled, and that fadeth not away, reserved in heaven for you. (1 Peter 1:4, KJV)

### Q3. What are we redeemed by?

**Answer:** B. The precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot

Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, as silver and gold... But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot. (1 Peter 1:18, KJV)

### Q4. What are we as a spiritual house?

**Answer:** A. Living stones built up a spiritual house, an holy priesthood

Ye also, as lively stones, are built up a spiritual house, an holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices, acceptable to God by Jesus Christ. (1 Peter 2:5, KJV)

### Q5. What did Peter call the believers?

But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light. (1 Peter 2:9, KJV)

### Q6. What did Peter say about suffering?

For even hereunto were ye called: because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that ye should follow his steps. (1 Peter 2:21, KJV)

### Q7. What did Peter say about wives?

**Answer:** A. Be in subjection to your own husbands

Likewise, ye wives, be in subjection to your own husbands; that, if any obey not the word, they also may without the word be won by the conversation of the wives. (1 Peter 3:1, KJV)

### Q8. What did Peter say about the end of all things?

**Answer:** A. Be sober, and watch unto prayer

But the end of all things is at hand: be ye therefore sober, and watch unto prayer. (1 Peter 4:7, KJV)

### Q9. What should we not think strange concerning the fiery trial?

**Answer:** A. It is to try you

Beloved, think it not strange concerning the fiery trial which is to try you, as though some strange thing happened unto you. (1 Peter 4:12, KJV)

**Q10.** Who is the chief Shepherd?

**Answer:** C. Jesus Christ

And when the chief Shepherd shall appear, ye shall receive a crown of glory that fadeth not away. (1 Peter 5:4, KJV)
