Answer Key & Explanations

Q1. What did Paul say comforted him in all his tribulation?

Answer: B. The God of all comfort

Blessed be God, even the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies, and the God of all comfort; Who comforteth us in all our tribulation. (2 Corinthians 1:3, KJV)

Q2. What did Paul say was the letter written not with ink?

Answer: A. The Spirit of the living God

Ye are our epistle written in our hearts, known and read of all men: Forasmuch as ye are manifestly declared to be the epistle of Christ ministered by us, written not with ink, but with the Spirit of the living God. (2 Corinthians 3:2, KJV)

Q3. What did Paul call his earthly body?

Answer: B. A tabernacle / earthly house of this tent

For we know that if our earthly house of this tabernacle were dissolved, we have a building of God, an house not made with hands, eternal in the heavens. (2 Corinthians 5:1, KJV)

Q4. What ministry did Paul say believers have received?

Answer: B. The ministry of reconciliation

And all things are of God, who hath reconciled us to himself by Jesus Christ, and hath given to us the ministry of reconciliation. (2 Corinthians 5:18, KJV)

Q5. What did Paul say Christ was made for us?

Answer: B. Sin for us, who knew no sin

He hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him. (2 Corinthians 5:21, KJV)

Q6. What did Paul urge the Corinthians not to be unequally yoked with?

Answer: A. Unbelievers

Be ye not unequally yoked together with unbelievers: for what fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness? (2 Corinthians 6:14, KJV)

Q7. What did Paul say God loves?

Answer: B. A cheerful giver

Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver. (2 Corinthians 9:7, KJV)

Q8. What did Paul say about his speaking?

Answer: C. Both of the above

His letters... are weighty and powerful; but his bodily presence is weak, and his speech contemptible. (2 Corinthians 10:10, KJV)

Q9. What did Paul say about Satan?

Answer: C. Both

In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them. (2 Corinthians 4:4, KJV)

Q10. What was Paul's thorn in the flesh?
