**Q1. What should we do when we fall into divers temptations?**

**Answer: B. Count it all joy**

My brethren, count it all joy when ye fall into divers temptations; Knowing this, that the trying of your faith worketh patience. (James 1:2, KJV)

**Q2. What should we ask God for in faith?**

**Answer: A. Wisdom**

If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him. (James 1:5, KJV)

**Q3. What should a double-minded man not expect?**

**Answer: A. To receive anything from the Lord**

But let him ask in faith, nothing wavering. For he that wavereth is like a wave of the sea driven with the wind and tossed... let not that man think that he shall receive any thing of the Lord. (James 1:6, KJV)

**Q4. What is the source of every good and perfect gift?**

**Answer: A. The Father of lights**

Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning. (James 1:17, KJV)
