Answer Key & Explanations

Q1. What tribe were the priests from?

Answer: B. Levi

The LORD spake unto Moses, saying, Bring the tribe of Levi near... (Numbers 3:5, KJV)

Q2. What was the first offering described in Leviticus?

Answer: B. The burnt offering

If any soul... will offer his oblation... he shall offer it of his own voluntary will... a burnt sacrifice. (Leviticus 1:3, KJV)

Q3. What did the burnt offering symbolize?

Answer: A. Total consecration to God

The burnt offering wholly ascended to God, representing total dedication. (Leviticus 1, KJV)

Q4. On what day was the high priest to enter the holy of holies?

Answer: B. The Day of Atonement

The tenth day of this seventh month there shall be a day of atonement... to make an atonement for you. (Leviticus 23:27, KJV)

Q5. What two animals were used on the Day of Atonement?

Answer: C. A bullock and a goat

Aaron shall offer his bullock of the sin offering... and he shall take the two goats. (Leviticus 16:6, KJV)

Q6. What happened to the scapegoat?

Answer: B. It was released into the wilderness

The goat... shall be presented alive before the LORD, to make an atonement with him, and to let him go for a scapegoat into the wilderness. (Leviticus 16:10, KJV)

Q7. How many times does Leviticus say 'I am the LORD'?

Answer: D. Over 50

The phrase 'I am the LORD' appears repeatedly throughout Leviticus as the seal of divine authority. (Leviticus 18:2, KJV)

Q8. What did God command Israel to do every seventh year?

Answer: B. Let the land rest / a sabbath of rest unto the land

Six years thou shalt prune thy vineyard... but in the seventh year shall be a sabbath of rest unto the land. (Leviticus 25:4, KJV)

Q9. How often was the Year of Jubilee?

Answer: C. Every 50 years

Thou shalt number seven sabbaths of years unto thee, seven times seven years... and ye shall hallow the fiftieth year. (Leviticus 25:10, KJV)

Q10. What is the closing call of Leviticus?

Answer: B. Be ye holy; for I am holy

Ye shall be holy unto me: for I the LORD am holy, and have severed you from other people, that ye should be mine. (Leviticus 20:26, KJV)
