Q1. What famine caused Elimelech to leave Bethlehem?

Answer: A. A famine in the land of Judah

There was a famine in the land... and a certain man of Bethlehemjudah went to sojourn in the country of Moab. (Ruth 1:1, KJV)

Q2. What did Naomi ask to be called?

Answer: A. Mara

Call me not Naomi, call me Mara: for the Almighty hath dealt very bitterly with me. (Ruth 1:20, KJV)

Q3. What famous words did Ruth speak to Naomi?

Answer: A. Whither thou goest, I will go

Intreat me not to leave thee... for whither thou goest, I will go; and where thou lodgest, I will lodge. (Ruth 1:16, KJV)

Q4. In whose field did Ruth glean?

Answer: B. Boaz

Her hap was to light on a part of the field belonging unto Boaz. (Ruth 2:3, KJV)

Q5. What did Boaz tell his reapers to do for Ruth?

Answer: C. Both

Let her glean even among the sheaves, and reproach her not... let fall also some of the handfuls of purpose for her. (Ruth 2:15, KJV)

Q6. What did Ruth ask Boaz to do at the threshing floor?
