Q1. What was Zechariah's grandfather's name?

Answer: C. Iddo and Berechiah

Zechariah the son of Berechiah, the son of Iddo the prophet. (Zechariah 1:1, KJV)

Q2. What did the four horns in the first vision represent?

Answer: C. Four Gentile powers that scattered Judah

These are the horns which have scattered Judah, Israel, and Jerusalem. (Zechariah 1:19, KJV)

Q3. Who stood before the angel of the LORD in the vision of chapter 3?

Answer: B. Joshua the high priest

And he shewed me Joshua the high priest standing before the angel of the LORD, and Satan standing at his right hand to resist him. (Zechariah 3:1, KJV)

Q4. What did the two olive trees in Zechariah 4 represent?

Answer: B. The two anointed ones, that stand by the Lord of the whole earth

These are the two anointed ones, that stand by the Lord of the whole earth. (Zechariah 4:14, KJV)

Q5. What was Zechariah told about Zerubbabel finishing the temple?

Answer: B. Not by might, nor by power, but by my spirit, saith the LORD of hosts

This is the word of the LORD unto Zerubbabel, saying, Not by might, nor by power, but by my spirit, saith the LORD of hosts. (Zechariah 4:6, KJV)

Q6. How is the coming King described in Zechariah 9:9?

Answer: B. Riding upon an ass, and upon a colt the foal of an ass

Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion; shout, O daughter of Jerusalem: behold, thy King cometh unto thee: he is just, and having salvation; lowly, and riding upon an ass, and upon a colt the foal of an ass. (Zechariah 9:9, KJV)

Q7. What does the LORD say about the fasts in Zechariah 8?

Answer: B. They shall be to the house of Judah joy and gladness, and cheerful feasts

The fast of the fourth month, and the fast of the fifth, and the fast of the seventh, and the fast of the tenth, shall be to the house of Judah joy and gladness, and cheerful feasts. (Zechariah 8:19, KJV)

Q8. What will happen to the one whom they have pierced, according to Zechariah 12:10?

Answer: A. They will mourn for him

They shall look upon me whom they have pierced, and they shall mourn for him, as one mourneth for his only son. (Zechariah 12:10, KJV)

Q9. What is the name of the shepherd who is smitten and the sheep scattered?

Answer: D. All of the above

Awake, O sword, against my shepherd, and against the man that is my fellow, saith the LORD of hosts: smite the shepherd, and the sheep shall be scattered. (Zechariah 13:7, KJV)

Q10. What will the LORD's feet stand upon in the day of battle?

Answer: B. The mount of Olives

Then shall the LORD go forth, and fight against those nations, as when he fought in the day of battle. And his feet shall stand in that day upon the mount of Olives. (Zechariah 14:3, KJV)
