Q1. What office did Caiaphas hold?

Answer: B. High priest

Matthew 26:3 (KJV) — 'The palace of the high priest, who was called Caiaphas.' (Matthew 26:3, KJV)

Q2. Whose son-in-law was Caiaphas?

Answer: A. Annas

John 18:13 (KJV) — 'Annas... was father in law to Caiaphas, which was the high priest that same year.' (John 18:13, KJV)

Q3. What did Caiaphas prophesy about Jesus in John 11?

Answer: B. It was expedient that one man should die for the people

John 11:50 (KJV) — 'It is expedient for us, that one man should die for the people.' (John 11:50, KJV)

Q4. What did Caiaphas charge Jesus to declare under oath?

Answer: B. Whether He was the Christ, the Son of God

Matthew 26:63 (KJV) — 'I adjure thee by the living God, that thou tell us whether thou be the Christ, the Son of God.' (Matthew 26:63, KJV)

Q5. What did Caiaphas do when Jesus affirmed He was the Son of God?

Answer: B. Rent his clothes

Matthew 26:65 (KJV) — 'Then the high priest rent his clothes, saying, He hath spoken blasphemy.' (Matthew 26:65, KJV)

Q6. What sentence did the council give Jesus under Caiaphas?

Answer: B. He is guilty of death

Matthew 26:66 (KJV) — 'They answered and said, He is guilty of death.' (Matthew 26:66, KJV)

Q7. Where did they bring Jesus from Caiaphas in the morning?

Answer: B. The hall of judgment (to Pilate)

John 18:28 (KJV) — 'Then led they Jesus from Caiaphas unto the hall of judgment.' (John 18:28, KJV)

Q8. In Luke 3, in whose high priesthood did the word of God come to John the Baptist?

Answer: A. Annas and Caiaphas

Luke 3:2 (KJV) — 'Annas and Caiaphas being the high priests, the word of God came unto John.' (Luke 3:2, KJV)

Q9. Caiaphas was present at Peter and John's trial in which book?

Answer: B. Acts

Acts 4:6 (KJV) — 'And Annas the high priest, and Caiaphas... were gathered together at Jerusalem.' (Acts 4:6, KJV)

Q10. Caiaphas' prophecy in John 11 referred to whose death?

Answer: B. Jesus' for the nation

John 11:51 (KJV) — 'He prophesied that Jesus should die for that nation.' (John 11:51, KJV)
