Q1. What was Cain's occupation?

Answer: B. Tiller of the ground

Genesis 4:2 (KJV) — 'Cain was a tiller of the ground.' (Genesis 4:2, KJV)

Q2. What was Abel's occupation?

Answer: A. A keeper of sheep

Genesis 4:2 (KJV) — 'Abel was a keeper of sheep.' (Genesis 4:2, KJV)

Q3. Whose offering did the LORD respect?

Answer: B. Abel's

Genesis 4:4 (KJV) — 'The LORD had respect unto Abel and to his offering.' (Genesis 4:4, KJV)

Q4. What did Cain offer to the LORD?

Answer: B. The fruit of the ground

Genesis 4:3 (KJV) — 'Cain brought of the fruit of the ground an offering unto the LORD.' (Genesis 4:3, KJV)

Q5. What did the LORD say lies at the door if Cain did not well?

Answer: A. Sin

Genesis 4:7 (KJV) — 'If thou doest not well, sin lieth at the door.' (Genesis 4:7, KJV)

Q6. Where did Cain kill Abel?

Answer: B. In the field

Genesis 4:8 (KJV) — 'When they were in the field... Cain rose up against Abel his brother, and slew him.' (Genesis 4:8, KJV)

Q7. What did Cain answer when asked where Abel was?

Answer: B. I know not; Am I my brother's keeper?

Genesis 4:9 (KJV) — 'I know not: Am I my brother's keeper?' (Genesis 4:9, KJV)

Q8. To what land did Cain go to dwell?

Answer: B. Nod

Genesis 4:16 (KJV) — 'Cain went out from the presence of the LORD, and dwelt in the land of Nod.' (Genesis 4:16, KJV)

Q9. By what did Abel offer a more excellent sacrifice?

Answer: B. By faith

Hebrews 11:4 (KJV) — 'By faith Abel offered unto God a more excellent sacrifice than Cain.' (Hebrews 11:4, KJV)

Q10. Why did Cain slay his brother, according to 1 John?

Answer: A. Because his own works were evil

1 John 3:12 (KJV) — 'Because his own works were evil, and his brother's righteous.' (1 John 3:12, KJV)
