Answer Key & Explanations

Q1. What is Paul if he speaks with the tongues of men and of angels but has not charity?

Answer: A. As sounding brass, or a tinkling cymbal

Though I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, and have not charity, I am become as sounding brass, or a tinkling cymbal. (1 Corinthians 13:1) (1 Corinthians 13:1, KJV)

Q2. What is Paul if he has prophetic understanding and faith to remove mountains but has not charity?

Answer: A. Nothing

And though I have the gift of prophecy, and understand all mysteries, and all knowledge; and though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains, and have not charity, I am nothing. (1 Corinthians 13:2) (1 Corinthians 13:2, KJV)

Q3. What profit is there if Paul gives all his goods to feed the poor and has not charity?

Answer: A. It profiteth me nothing

And though I bestow all my goods to feed the poor, and though I give my body to be burned, and have not charity, it profiteth me nothing. (1 Corinthians 13:3) (1 Corinthians 13:3, KJV)

Q4. How does charity suffer?

Answer: A. Long, and is kind

Charity suffereth long, and is kind; charity envieth not; charity vaunteth not itself, is not puffed up. (1 Corinthians 13:4) (1 Corinthians 13:4, KJV)

Q5. What does charity not behave itself?

Answer: A. Unseemly

Doth not behave itself unseemly, seeketh not her own, is not easily provoked, thinketh no evil. (1 Corinthians 13:5) (1 Corinthians 13:5, KJV)

Q6. What does charity rejoice in?

Answer: A. The truth

Rejoiceth not in iniquity, but rejoiceth in the truth. (1 Corinthians 13:6) (1 Corinthians 13:6, KJV)

Q7. What does charity do with all things?

Answer: A. Beareth, believeth, hopeth, endureth

Beareth all things, believeth all things, hopeth all things, endureth all things. (1 Corinthians 13:7) (1 Corinthians 13:7, KJV)

Q8. What does charity never do?

Answer: A. Fail

Charity never faileth: but whether there be prophecies, they shall fail; whether there be tongues, they shall cease; whether there be knowledge, it shall vanish away. (1 Corinthians 13:8) (1 Corinthians 13:8, KJV)

Q9. What three things abide?

Answer: A. Faith, hope, charity

And now abideth faith, hope, charity, these three; but the greatest of these is charity. (1 Corinthians 13:13) (1 Corinthians 13:13, KJV)

Q10. Which of the three is the greatest?

Answer: A. Charity
