Q1. What are we told to do with the spirits?

Answer: A. Try the spirits whether they are of God

Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world. (1 John 4:1) (1 John 4:1, KJV)

Q2. How is the Spirit of God known?

Answer: A. Every spirit that confesseth that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is of God

Hereby know ye the Spirit of God: Every spirit that confesseth that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is of God. (1 John 4:2) (1 John 4:2, KJV)

Q3. Greater is he that is in you than who?

Answer: A. He that is in the world

Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world. (1 John 4:4) (1 John 4:4, KJV)

Q4. Who is born of God and knows God?

Answer: A. Every one that loveth

Beloved, let us love one another: for love is of God; and every one that loveth is born of God, and knoweth God. (1 John 4:7) (1 John 4:7, KJV)

Q5. What is God?

Answer: A. Love

He that loveth not knoweth not God; for God is love. (1 John 4:8) (1 John 4:8, KJV)

Q6. How was the love of God manifested toward us?

Answer: A. God sent his only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through him

In this was manifested the love of God toward us, because that God sent his only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through him. (1 John 4:9) (1 John 4:9, KJV)

Q7. What is the propitiation for our sins?

Answer: A. He sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins

Herein is love, not that we loved God, but that he loved us, and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins. (1 John 4:10) (1 John 4:10, KJV)

Q8. What casts out fear?

Answer: A. Perfect love casteth out fear

There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear: because fear hath torment. He that feareth is not made perfect in love. (1 John 4:18) (1 John 4:18, KJV)

Q9. Why do we love him?

Answer: A. Because he first loved us

We love him, because he first loved us. (1 John 4:19) (1 John 4:19, KJV)

Q10. What is the commandment from him?

Answer: A. He who loveth God love his brother also

And this commandment have we from him, That he who loveth God love his brother also. (1 John 4:21) (1 John 4:21, KJV)
