Q1. What do we have if our earthly house of this tabernacle were dissolved?

Answer: A. A building of God, an house not made with hands, eternal in the heavens

For we know that if our earthly house of this tabernacle were dissolved, we have a building of God, an house not made with hands, eternal in the heavens. (2 Corinthians 5:1) (2 Corinthians 5:1, KJV)

Q2. What has God given us as the earnest of the Spirit?

Answer: A. The Spirit Himself as earnest

Now he that hath wrought us for the selfsame thing is God, who also hath given unto us the earnest of the Spirit. (2 Corinthians 5:5) (2 Corinthians 5:5, KJV)

Q3. We walk by faith, not by what?

Answer: A. Sight

(For we walk by faith, not by sight:) (2 Corinthians 5:7) (2 Corinthians 5:7, KJV)

Q4. Where must we all appear?

Answer: A. Before the judgment seat of Christ

For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ; that every one may receive the things done in his body. (2 Corinthians 5:10) (2 Corinthians 5:10, KJV)

Q5. What constrains the believer?

Answer: A. The love of Christ

For the love of Christ constraineth us; because we thus judge, that if one died for all, then were all dead. (2 Corinthians 5:14) (2 Corinthians 5:14, KJV)

Q6. If any man be in Christ, he is a what?

Answer: A. New creature

Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new. (2 Corinthians 5:17) (2 Corinthians 5:17, KJV)

Q7. What ministry has God given to us?

Answer: A. The ministry of reconciliation

And all things are of God, who hath reconciled us to himself by Jesus Christ, and hath given to us the ministry of reconciliation. (2 Corinthians 5:18) (2 Corinthians 5:18, KJV)

Q8. We are ambassadors for whom?

Answer: A. Christ

Now then we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God did beseech you by us: we pray you in Christ's stead, be ye reconciled to God. (2 Corinthians 5:20) (2 Corinthians 5:20, KJV)

Q9. Who was made sin for us, who knew no sin?

Answer: A. Christ

For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him. (2 Corinthians 5:21) (2 Corinthians 5:21, KJV)

Q10. What might we be made in Him?

Answer: A. The righteousness of God
