Answer Key & Explanations

Q1. Where was Moses when he saw the burning bush?

Answer: B. Mount Horeb

Now Moses kept the flock of Jethro his father in law, the priest of Midian: and he led the flock to the backside of the desert, and came to the mountain of God, even to Horeb. (Exodus 3:1) (Exodus 3:1, KJV)

Q2. What was unusual about the bush?

Answer: B. It burned with fire, yet was not consumed

And the angel of the LORD appeared unto him in a flame of fire out of the midst of a bush: and he looked, and, behold, the bush burned with fire, and the bush was not consumed. (Exodus 3:2) (Exodus 3:2, KJV)

Q3. What did God tell Moses to do?

Answer: A. Do not draw nigh hither: put off thy shoes from off thy feet, for the place whereon thou standest is holy ground

And he said, Draw not nigh hither: put off thy shoes from off thy feet, for the place whereon thou standest is holy ground. (Exodus 3:5) (Exodus 3:5, KJV)

Q4. What did God say He had seen and heard?

Answer: A. The affliction of his people in Egypt

I have surely seen the affliction of my people which are in Egypt, and have heard their cry by reason of their taskmasters. (Exodus 3:7) (Exodus 3:7, KJV)

Q5. What land did God promise to bring Israel into?

Answer: A. A land flowing with milk and honey

And I am come down to deliver them out of the hand of the Egyptians, and to bring them up out of that land unto a good land and a large, unto a land flowing with milk and honey. (Exodus 3:8) (Exodus 3:8, KJV)

Q6. Who did God say would go with Moses to Pharaoh?

Answer: A. Aaron

And thou shalt come, thou and the elders of Israel, unto the king of Egypt... (Exodus 3:18) — God told Moses He would go with him. (Exodus 3:12) (Exodus 3:12, KJV)

Q7. What name did God reveal to Moses?

Answer: B. I AM THAT I AM

And God said unto Moses, I AM THAT I AM: and he said, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, I AM hath sent me unto you. (Exodus 3:14) (Exodus 3:14, KJV)

Q8. What was Moses' first objection?

Answer: A. Who am I, that I should go unto Pharaoh?

And Moses said unto God, Who am I, that I should go unto Pharaoh, and that I should bring forth the children of Israel out of Egypt? (Exodus 3:11) (Exodus 3:11, KJV)

Q9. What did Moses ask in case the people did not believe him?

Answer: A. What is his name?

Behold, when I come unto the children of Israel, and shall say unto them, The God of your fathers hath sent me unto you; and they shall say to me, What is his name? (Exodus 3:13) (Exodus 3:13, KJV)

Q10. What did God say the elders of Israel would do when Moses told them?

Answer: B. Hearken to his voice

And they shall hearken to thy voice. (Exodus 3:18) (Exodus 3:18, KJV)
