## Answer Key & Explanations

**Q1. What did the LORD tell Abram to leave?**

**Answer:** A. His country, kindred, and father's house

Now the LORD had said unto Abram, Get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and from thy father's house, unto a land that I will shew thee. (Genesis 12:1) (Genesis 12:1, KJV)

**Q2. What three things did God promise to make Abram?**

**Answer:** A. A great nation, to bless him, and make his name great

And I will make of thee a great nation, and I will bless thee, and make thy name great; and thou shalt be a blessing. (Genesis 12:2) (Genesis 12:2, KJV)

**Q3. What did God say about those who bless and curse Abram?**

**Answer:** A. I will bless them that bless thee, and curse him that curseth thee

And I will bless them that bless thee, and curse him that curseth thee: and in thee shall all families of the earth be blessed. (Genesis 12:3) (Genesis 12:3, KJV)

**Q4. How old was Abram when he departed from Haran?**

**Answer:** C. Seventy-five years old

So Abram departed, as the LORD had spoken unto him; and Lot went with him: and Abram was seventy and five years old when he departed out of Haran. (Genesis 12:4) (Genesis 12:4, KJV)

**Q5. Who went with Abram from Haran?**

**Answer:** A. Sarai, Lot, and all their substance

And Abram took Sarai his wife, and Lot his brother's son, and all their substance that they had gathered, and the souls that they had gotten in Haran. (Genesis 12:5) (Genesis 12:5, KJV)

**Q6. Where did Abram build his first altar unto the LORD in Canaan?**

**Answer:** A. Unto the place of Sichem, unto the plain of Moreh

And Abram passed through the land unto the place of Sichem, unto the plain of Moreh. And the Canaanite was then in the land. And the LORD appeared unto Abram, and said, Unto thy seed will I give this land: and there builded he an altar unto the LORD. (Genesis 12:6-7) (Genesis 12:7, KJV)

**Q7. Why did Abram go down into Egypt?**

**Answer:** A. For there was a famine in the land

And there was a famine in the land: and Abram went down into Egypt to sojourn there; for the famine was grievous in the land. (Genesis 12:10) (Genesis 12:10, KJV)

**Q8. What did Abram ask Sarai to do in Egypt?**

**Answer:** A. Say she was his sister, because he feared they would kill him for his wife

And it came to pass, when he was come near to enter into Egypt, that he said unto Sarai his wife... Say, I pray thee, thou art my sister: that it may be well with me for thy sake; and my soul shall live because of thee. (Genesis 12:11-13) (Genesis 12:13, KJV)

**Q9. What did Pharaoh do when he saw Sarai?**

**Answer:** C. Both of the above

The Egyptians beheld the woman that she was very fair. The princes also of Pharaoh saw her, and commended her before Pharaoh: and the woman was taken into Pharaoh's house. And he entreated Abram well for her sake: and he had sheep, and oxen, and he asses, and menservants, and maidservants, and she asses, and camels. (Genesis 12:14-16) (Genesis 12:15, KJV)

**Q10.** How did the LORD plague Pharaoh?

**Answer:** A. With great plagues because of Sarai Abram's wife

And the LORD plagued Pharaoh and his house with great plagues because of Sarai Abram's wife. (Genesis 12:17)
