Q1. What creature was more subtil than any beast of the field?

Answer: A. The serpent

Now the serpent was more subtil than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. (Genesis 3:1) (Genesis 3:1, KJV)

Q2. What did the serpent ask the woman?

Answer: A. Yea, hath God said, Ye shall not eat of every tree of the garden?

And he said unto the woman, Yea, hath God said, Ye shall not eat of every tree of the garden? (Genesis 3:1) (Genesis 3:1, KJV)

Q3. What did the woman say about the tree in the midst of the garden?

Answer: A. God hath said, Ye shall not eat of it, neither shall ye touch it, lest ye die

But of the fruit of the tree which is in the midst of the garden, God hath said, Ye shall not eat of it, neither shall ye touch it, lest ye die. (Genesis 3:3) (Genesis 3:3, KJV)

Q4. What did the serpent say about dying?

Answer: B. Ye shall not surely die

And the serpent said unto the woman, Ye shall not surely die. (Genesis 3:4) (Genesis 3:4, KJV)

Q5. What did the serpent promise would happen if they ate?

Answer: A. Ye shall be as gods, knowing good and evil

For God doth know that in the day ye eat thereof, then your eyes shall be opened, and ye shall be as gods, knowing good and evil. (Genesis 3:5) (Genesis 3:5, KJV)

Q6. What was the tree good for?

Answer: A. For food, pleasant to the eyes, and to be desired to make one wise

And when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was pleasant to the eyes, and a tree to be desired to make one wise, she took of the fruit thereof, and did eat. (Genesis 3:6) (Genesis 3:6, KJV)

Q7. What did Adam and Eve use to make themselves aprons?

Answer: A. Fig leaves

And the eyes of them both were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and they sewed fig leaves together, and made themselves aprons. (Genesis 3:7) (Genesis 3:7, KJV)

Q8. Where did Adam and Eve hide from the LORD?

Answer: A. Among the trees of the garden

And Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God amongst the trees of the garden. (Genesis 3:8) (Genesis 3:8, KJV)

Q9. What did God say would bruise the serpent's head?

Answer: A. The seed of the woman

And I will put enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and her seed; it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heel. (Genesis 3:15) (Genesis 3:15, KJV)

Q10. What did the LORD God make for Adam and his wife?

Answer: A. Coats of skins

Unto Adam also and to his wife did the LORD God make coats of skins, and clothed them. (Genesis 3:21) (Genesis 3:21, KJV)
