Answer Key & Explanations

Q1. Who came to Jesus by night?

Answer: A. Nicodemus, a ruler of the Jews

There was a man of the Pharisees, named Nicodemus, a ruler of the Jews: The same came to Jesus by night. (John 3:1-2) (John 3:1, KJV)

Q2. What did Nicodemus acknowledge about Jesus?

Answer: A. Rabbi, we know that thou art a teacher come from God

Rabbi, we know that thou art a teacher come from God: for no man can do these miracles that thou doest, except God be with him. (John 3:2) (John 3:2, KJV)

Q3. What did Jesus say a man must do to see the kingdom of God?

Answer: A. Be born again

Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God. (John 3:3) (John 3:3, KJV)

Q4. How did Nicodemus misunderstand being born again?

Answer: A. Can he enter the second time into his mother's womb, and be born?

Nicodemus saith unto him, How can a man be born when he is old? can he enter the second time into his mother's womb, and be born? (John 3:4) (John 3:4, KJV)

Q5. What two births did Jesus say are necessary?

Answer: A. Of water and of the Spirit

Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God. (John 3:5) (John 3:5, KJV)

Q6. What does Jesus compare the wind to?

Answer: A. The sound and movement of the Spirit

The wind bloweth where it listeth, and thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth: so is every one that is born of the Spirit. (John 3:8) (John 3:8, KJV)

Q7. What did Jesus say Moses lifted up in the wilderness?

Answer: A. The brazen serpent

And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of man be lifted up. (John 3:14) (John 3:14, KJV)

Q8. Why did God send His Son into the world?

Answer: A. That the world through him might be saved

For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved. (John 3:17) (John 3:17, KJV)

Q9. What happens to those who do not believe?

Answer: A. They are condemned already

He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God. (John 3:18) (John 3:18, KJV)
