Q1. Where did Jesus go to teach?

Answer: A. Up into a mountain

And seeing the multitudes, he went up into a mountain: and when he was set, his disciples came unto him. (Matthew 5:1) (Matthew 5:1, KJV)

Q2. What are the poor in spirit promised?

Answer: A. The kingdom of heaven

Blessed are the poor in spirit: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. (Matthew 5:3) (Matthew 5:3, KJV)

Q3. What are those who mourn promised?

Answer: A. They shall be comforted

Blessed are they that mourn: for they shall be comforted. (Matthew 5:4) (Matthew 5:4, KJV)

Q4. What are the meek promised?

Answer: A. They shall inherit the earth

Blessed are the meek: for they shall inherit the earth. (Matthew 5:5) (Matthew 5:5, KJV)

Q5. What does Jesus call His disciples?

Answer: C. Both of the above

Ye are the salt of the earth... Ye are the light of the world. (Matthew 5:13-14) (Matthew 5:13, KJV)

Q6. What does Jesus say He came to do with the law?

But I say unto you, That ye resist not evil: but whosoever shall smite thee on thy right cheek, turn to him the other also. (Matthew 5:39) (Matthew 5:39, KJV)
