**Q1.** What should we not do when we give alms?

**Answer:** B. Sound a trumpet before thee, as the hypocrites do

Therefore when thou doest thine alms, do not sound a trumpet before thee, as the hypocrites do. (Matthew 6:2) (Matthew 6:2, KJV)

**Q2.** Where should we lay up treasures?

**Answer:** C. In heaven

But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt. (Matthew 6:20) (Matthew 6:20, KJV)

**Q3.** What does Jesus say the eye is?

**Answer:** A. The lamp of the body

The light of the body is the eye. (Matthew 6:22) (Matthew 6:22, KJV)

**Q4.** Who can add a cubit to his stature by taking thought?

**Answer:** C. No one

Which of you by taking thought can add one cubit unto his stature? (Matthew 6:27) (Matthew 6:27, KJV)

**Q5.** What does Jesus say about the birds of the air?

**Answer:** A. They neither sow nor reap, yet your heavenly Father feedeth them

Behold the fowls of the air: for they sow not, neither do they reap, nor gather into barns; yet your heavenly Father feedeth them. (Matthew 6:26) (Matthew 6:26, KJV)

**Q6.** How does Jesus teach us to address God in prayer?

**Answer:** B. Our Father which art in heaven

After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven. (Matthew 6:9) (Matthew 6:9, KJV)

**Q7.** What do we ask to be done on earth as it is in heaven?

**Answer:** A. Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done

Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven. (Matthew 6:10) (Matthew 6:10, KJV)

**Q8.** What does Jesus say we should seek first?

**Answer:** B. The kingdom of God, and his righteousness

But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you. (Matthew 6:33) (Matthew 6:33, KJV)

**Q9.** How should we forgive others?

**Answer:** B. As we would be forgiven

For if ye forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. (Matthew 6:14) (Matthew 6:14, KJV)

**Q10.** What should we not be like when we fast?

**Answer:** B. Of a sad countenance, disfiguring our faces

Moreover when ye fast, be not, as the hypocrites, of a sad countenance: for they disfigure their faces. (Matthew 6:16) (Matthew 6:16, KJV)
