## Answer Key & Explanations

**Q1. How many men did Moses send to spy out Canaan?**

**Answer:** B. Twelve

Send thou men, that they may search the land of Canaan, which I give unto the children of Israel: of every tribe of their fathers shall ye send a man, every one a ruler among them. (Numbers 13:2) (Numbers 13:2, KJV)

**Q2. From which wilderness did Moses send them?**

**Answer:** A. The wilderness of Paran

And Moses by the commandment of the LORD sent them from the wilderness of Paran. (Numbers 13:3) (Numbers 13:3, KJV)

**Q3. What fruit did they cut down from the brook of Eshcol?**

**Answer:** B. Grapes, pomegranates, and figs

And they came unto the brook of Eshcol, and cut down from thence a branch with one cluster of grapes, and they bare it between two upon a staff; and they brought of the pomegranates, and of the figs. (Numbers 13:23) (Numbers 13:23, KJV)

**Q4. How many men carried the cluster of grapes?**

**Answer:** B. Two

They bare it between two upon a staff. (Numbers 13:23) (Numbers 13:23, KJV)

**Q5. How long did they search the land?**

**Answer:** C. Forty days

And they returned from searching of the land after forty days. (Numbers 13:25) (Numbers 13:25, KJV)

**Q6. What did the spies say the land flowed with?**

Surely it floweth with milk and honey; and this is the fruit of it. (Numbers 13:27) (Numbers 13:27, KJV)

**Q7. How did the ten spies describe the people of the land?**

**Answer:** A. They are stronger than we

Nevertheless the people be strong that dwell in the land, and the cities are walled, and very great: and moreover we saw the children of Anak there. (Numbers 13:28) (Numbers 13:28, KJV)

**Q8. How did Caleb describe the land?**

**Answer:** C. A land which we passed through to search it, is an exceeding good land

And Caleb stilled the people before Moses, and said, Let us go up at once, and possess it; for we are well able to overcome it. (Numbers 13:30) (Numbers 13:30, KJV)

**Q9. What did the ten spies say they were like in their own sight?**

**Answer:** A. As grasshoppers

And there we saw the giants, the sons of Anak, which come of the giants: and we were in our own sight as grasshoppers, and so we were in their sight. (Numbers 13:33) (Numbers 13:33, KJV)

**Q10.** Which two spies brought a good report?

**Answer:** A. Joshua and Caleb

But Joshua the son of Nun, and Caleb the son of Jephunneh, which were of them that searched the land, rent their clothes: And they spake unto all the company of the children of Israel, saying, The land, which we passed through to search it, is an exceeding good land. (Numbers 14:6-7) (Numbers 14:6, KJV)
