**Q1. What mind should be in us?**

**Answer:** A. Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus

Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus. (Philippians 2:5) (Philippians 2:5, KJV)

**Q2. What did Christ think it not robbery to be?**

**Answer:** A. Equal with God

Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God. (Philippians 2:6) (Philippians 2:6, KJV)

**Q3. What did Christ make Himself?**

**Answer:** A. Of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant

But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men. (Philippians 2:7) (Philippians 2:7, KJV)

**Q4. To what death did Christ become obedient?**

**Answer:** A. The death of the cross

And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross. (Philippians 2:8) (Philippians 2:8, KJV)

**Q5. What name has God given Jesus?**

**Answer:** A. A name which is above every name

Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name. (Philippians 2:9) (Philippians 2:9, KJV)

**Q6. What shall every knee do at the name of Jesus?**

**Answer:** A. Bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth

That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth. (Philippians 2:10) (Philippians 2:10, KJV)

**Q7. What shall every tongue confess?**

**Answer:** A. That Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father

And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. (Philippians 2:11) (Philippians 2:11, KJV)

**Q8. How are we to work out our salvation?**

**Answer:** A. With fear and trembling

Wherefore, my beloved, as ye have always obeyed... work out your own salvation with fear and trembling. (Philippians 2:12) (Philippians 2:12, KJV)

**Q9. Who works in us both to will and to do of His good pleasure?**

**Answer:** A. God

For it is God which worketh in you both to will and to do of his good pleasure. (Philippians 2:13) (Philippians 2:13, KJV)

**Q10. How are we to do all things?**

**Answer:** A. Without murmurings and disputings

Do all things without murmurings and disputings. (Philippians 2:14) (Philippians 2:14, KJV)
