Answer Key & Explanations

Q1. What is there now to them which are in Christ Jesus?

Answer: A. No condemnation

There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit. (Romans 8:1) (Romans 8:1, KJV)

Q2. What has the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus done?

Answer: A. Made me free from the law of sin and death

For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death. (Romans 8:2) (Romans 8:2, KJV)

Q3. What did God send His own Son in the likeness of?

Answer: A. Sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh

For what the law could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, God sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh. (Romans 8:3) (Romans 8:3, KJV)

Q4. What are those who are after the Spirit minded?

Answer: A. The things of the Spirit

For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; but they that are after the Spirit the things of the Spirit. (Romans 8:5) (Romans 8:5, KJV)

Q5. What does the Spirit of adoption make us cry?

Answer: A. Abba, Father

For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father. (Romans 8:15) (Romans 8:15, KJV)

Q6. What do the Spirit and the children of God witness together?

Answer: A. That we are the children of God

The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God. (Romans 8:16) (Romans 8:16, KJV)

Q7. What are the sufferings of this present time not worthy to be compared with?

Answer: A. The glory which shall be revealed in us

For I reckon that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us. (Romans 8:18) (Romans 8:18, KJV)

Q8. What does all creation groan and travail in pain for?

Answer: A. Waiting for the adoption, to wit, the redemption of our body

For we know that the whole creation groaneth and travaileth in pain together until now. And not only they, but ourselves also, which have the firstfruits of the Spirit, even we ourselves groan within ourselves, waiting for the adoption, to wit, the redemption of our body. (Romans 8:22-23) (Romans 8:22, KJV)

Q9. What does Romans 8:28 say God works for those who love Him?

Answer: A. All things work together for good

And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose. (Romans 8:28) (Romans 8:28, KJV)

Q10. What does Paul say shall be able to separate us from the love of God?

Answer: A. Nothing — neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature

For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord. (Romans 8:38-39) (Romans 8:38, KJV)
