Q1. In the first chapter, Paul gives thanks to God for the Colossians' faith in Christ Jesus and their love toward whom?

Answer: A. All the saints

Paul mentions their love 'to all the saints' in his opening thanksgiving. (Colossians 1:4, KJV)

Q2. Who is described as a 'dear fellowservant' and a 'faithful minister of Christ' who declared the Colossians' love in the Spirit?

Answer: B. Epaphras

Epaphras is identified as their faithful minister and Paul's fellowservant. (Colossians 1:7, KJV)

Q3. According to Colossians 1:15, Christ is the image of the invisible God and the firstborn of every what?

Answer: C. Creature

The text states He is the 'firstborn of every creature.' (Colossians 1:15, KJV)

Q4. Paul warns the believers to beware lest any man spoil them through what two things?

Answer: B. Philosophy and vain deceit

Paul warns against 'philosophy and vain deceit, after the tradition of men.' (Colossians 2:8, KJV)

Q5. What did Christ blot out, nailing it to his cross?

Answer: A. The handwriting of ordinances

He blotted out 'the handwriting of ordinances that was against us.' (Colossians 2:14, KJV)

Q6. If ye then be risen with Christ, what things does Paul say we should seek?

Answer: B. Those things which are above

Paul exhorts believers to 'seek those things which are above.' (Colossians 3:1, KJV)

Q7. What is called 'the bond of perfectness' in the third chapter?

Answer: C. Charity

Paul instructs to put on charity, which is the bond of perfectness. (Colossians 3:14, KJV)

Q8. Paul instructs that whatever we do in word or deed, we should do all in whose name?

Answer: B. The name of the Lord Jesus

The scripture says to 'do all in the name of the Lord Jesus.' (Colossians 3:17, KJV)

Q9. Paul commands that our speech be always with grace, seasoned with what?

Answer: C. Salt

The text says speech should be 'always with grace, seasoned with salt.' (Colossians 4:6, KJV)

Q10. Which individual is described as 'the beloved physician' in the final chapter?

Answer: B. Luke

Paul sends greetings from 'Luke, the beloved physician.' (Colossians 4:14, KJV)
