Q1. What city did Cornelius live in?

There was a certain man in Caesarea called Cornelius, a centurion of the band called the Italian band. (Acts 10:1, KJV)

Answer: A. The Italian band

A centurion of the band called the Italian band. (Acts 10:1, KJV)

Q3. How is Cornelius described?

Answer: A. A devout man, and one that feared God

A devout man, and one that feared God with all his house, which gave much alms to the people, and prayed to God alway. (Acts 10:2, KJV)

Q4. At what hour did the angel appear to Cornelius?

Answer: A. The ninth hour of the day

He saw in a vision evidently about the ninth hour of the day an angel of God coming in to him. (Acts 10:3, KJV)

Q5. To what city was Cornelius told to send men?

Answer: A. Joppa, for Simon Peter

Send men to Joppa, and call for one Simon, whose surname is Peter. (Acts 10:5, KJV)

Q6. What did Peter see in his vision on the housetop?

Answer: A. A great sheet let down from heaven with all manner of beasts

And saw heaven opened, and a certain vessel descending unto him, as it had been a great sheet knit at the four corners, and let down to the earth. (Acts 10:11, KJV)

Q7. What did the voice tell Peter?

Answer: A. Rise, Peter; kill, and eat

And there came a voice to him, Rise, Peter; kill, and eat. (Acts 10:13, KJV)

Q8. What did Cornelius do when he met Peter?

Answer: A. Fell down at his feet, and worshipped him

And as Peter was coming in, Cornelius met him, and fell down at his feet, and worshipped him. (Acts 10:25, KJV)

Q9. What did Peter declare in Cornelius's house?

Then Peter opened his mouth, and said, Of a truth I perceive that God is no respecter of persons. (Acts 10:34, KJV)

Q10. What happened while Peter was still preaching?

Answer: A. The Holy Ghost fell on all them which heard the word

While Peter yet spake these words, the Holy Ghost fell on all them which heard the word. (Acts 10:44, KJV)
