Answer Key & Explanations

Q1. According to Deuteronomy 6:5, how are the children of Israel commanded to love the LORD their God?

Answer: A. With all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might
This is the great commandment known as the Shema. (Deuteronomy 6:5, KJV)

Q2. Upon which mountain did Moses stand to view the promised land before he died?

Answer: C. Mount Nebo
Moses went up from the plains of Moab unto the mountain of Nebo. (Deuteronomy 34:1, KJV)

Q3. Man doth not live by bread only, but by what proceedeth out of the mouth of the LORD. Where is this found?

Answer: B. Deuteronomy 8:3
Moses reminded the people of how God fed them with manna to teach this lesson. (Deuteronomy 8:3, KJV)

Q4. Which two mountains were designated for the pronouncing of blessings and cursings?

Answer: C. Gerizim and Ebal
The blessing was put upon mount Gerizim, and the curse upon mount Ebal. (Deuteronomy 11:29, KJV)

Q5. How old was Moses when he died in the land of Moab?

Answer: C. 120 years old
Moses was an hundred and twenty years old when he died. (Deuteronomy 34:7, KJV)

Q6. What was the name of the giant king of Bashan whose bedstead was made of iron?

Answer: B. Og
Only Og king of Bashan remained of the remnant of giants. (Deuteronomy 3:11, KJV)

Q7. Who was chosen to succeed Moses and lead the people into the land?

Answer: C. Joshua
The LORD said unto Moses that Joshua should cause Israel to inherit the land. (Deuteronomy 1:38, KJV)

Q8. In the 'Song of Moses,' God is frequently referred to by what metaphor of stability?

Answer: A. The Rock
He is the Rock, his work is perfect: for all his ways are judgment. (Deuteronomy 32:4, KJV)

Q9. What was the specific reason given why Moses was not allowed to go over Jordan?

Answer: C. Because the LORD was wrath with him for the people's sakes
Moses stated the LORD was wrath with him for their sakes and would not hear him. (Deuteronomy 3:26, KJV)

Q10. Every how many years was the 'year of release' to be observed regarding debts?

Answer: A. Every seven years
At the end of every seven years thou shalt make a release. (Deuteronomy 15:1, KJV)
